*Other Financial Considerations:	
Students ability to work while attending the program is greatly compromised due to the rigour of curriculum and scheduling of courses and labs. Often labs need to be scheduled outside of regular hours in order to access clinical areas. Students ability to obtain summer employment is limited by required attendance in full-time (30 to 35 hours per week in clinic, depending on the year, and additional time required for working on a research project in the third year) Spring/Summer courses. All costs related to clinical placements (housing, travel, food etc.) are the students responsibility.
