Thesis Registration (Ongoing)

Full-time students in thesis-based programs must register in each term (Fall, Winter, Spring and Summer).

Fall/Winter Terms

- To be considered full-time, students must be registered in a minimum of 9 credits
- This will be comprised of coursework and/or thesis registration:
 - 9 credits of coursework + no thesis registration
 - 6 credits of coursework + THES 903 (★3)
 - 3 credits of coursework + THES 906 (★6)
 - 0 credits of coursework + THES 909 (★9)

Spring/Summer Terms

- To be considered full-time, students must be registered in a minimum of 6 credits
- FGPS will automatically add registration in THES 906 (★6) to each thesis-based student's BearTracks account
- Courses taken in Spring/Summer, are assessed at an **additional** cost

Degree Requirements at a Glance

The FGPS's minimum core graduate academic requirements must be successfully met for that graduate credential to be awarded. Programs may wish to add their own supplemental requirements, in alignment with the University's established governance structures.

- Student completed the ethics and academic citizenship training (INT D 710 and INT D 720) required by FGPS.
- Student successfully completed all coursework, as required by the program.
- Student completed a doctoral candidacy exam, as required by their program.
- Student successfully defend their thesis, in real time, as determined by the examining committee.
- Student produced a published/recorded thesis commensurate with the degree being sought.

Students Admitted Fall 2011 and thereafter: Over the duration of their program, students in a doctoral program admitted Fall 2011 and thereafter must pay the equivalent of at least three full years of program fees; see [Graduate Instructional and Non-Instructional Fees](#), in addition to fulfilling the doctoral program requirements.
