- 3. Matters Arising from the Minutes
 - a. Memo to the Deans Discussion:
 - A concern was raised that during the consultation process there was no opportunity for discussion in the Faculty of Medicine. Mazi responded that the consultation process was comprehensive and Catherine Swindlehurst can still contact departments in Medicine.
 - The process is expected to conclude and a resulting report should be available before Christmas. The timeline was proposed because.... When President Samarasekera had a team review the portfolio of the Provost, it included the recommendation that FGSR be abolished.
 - The GSA says they continue to have questions about what will happen next. No commitment has been made and the consultation has been informal and not well defined.
 - A formal review of the FGSR is set for 2014-15.
 - President Samarasekera stated in the town hall meeting on November 16, 2012 that the FGSR is not being dismantled.
 - Students of the GSA are also interested in having input in the consultation process.

Motion to add ADRs as a specific category to the WGQM was PUT but NOT CARRIED.

4. <u>Motion 1</u>: The Establishment of the Working Group on Quality Measures for Graduate Programs (WGQM). M – J Harrington, 2nd L Thorlakson

There was a suggestion that there was a need for more volunteer group members.

Motion to Approve the Establishment of the WGQM was PUT and CARRIED. Yes – 47. No – 1. Abstain – 1.

 Motion 2: Approval of the membership of the WGQM. M – Rene P, 2nd - A Bernier

Amendment – Fine Arts be added to the membership.

Fine Arts felt they weren't represented on the group. The methods they use to measure grad students are different from other faculties, i.e. auditions, performances.

The response was that the working group looks at how quality measures are done, reviews, and forwards suggestions to FGSR Council, so the size of the group has to be manageable.

Motion that Fine Arts be added to the membership of the WGQM was PUT and Carried.
