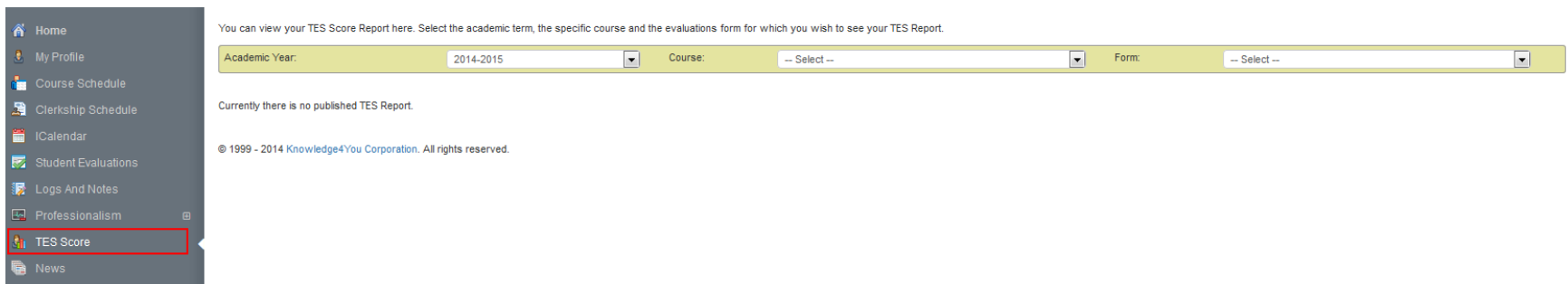
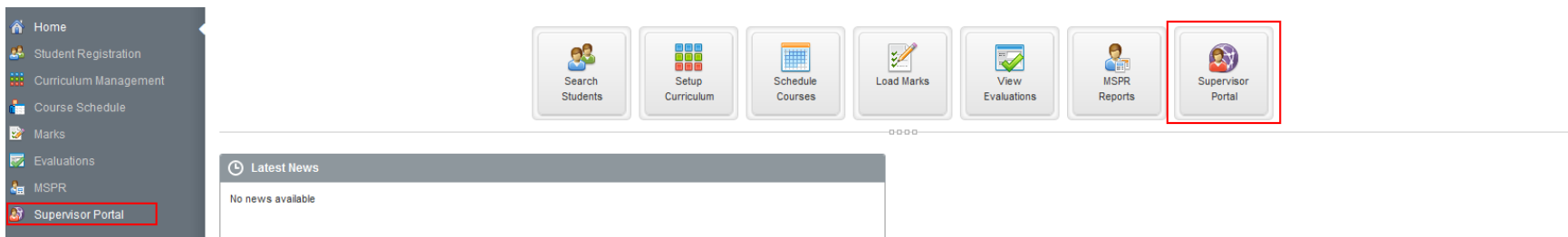


Accessing Instructor Evaluation(s) in MedSIS
