- (1) Students who have not paid their fees in full by this date, or made satisfactory alternate arrangements, will have their registrations withdrawn.
- (2) Students withdrawing after this date will be assessed full fees.
- (3) If you withdraw from a two-term course from May 22/2001 to July 11/2001, you will be assessed full fees for the Spring Term. If you withdraw from July 11/2001 to July 23/2001, you will be assessed Spring-Term fees and 50% of Summer-Term fees. If you withdraw after July 23/2001, you will be assessed full fees for both terms.
- (4) Beyond this date, registration will be cancelled for non-payment of the deposit.
- (5) If you withdraw from a two-term course from October 6/2001 to January 11/2002, you will be assessed full fees for the Fall Term. If you withdraw from January 12/2002 to February 6/2002, you will be assessed Fall-Term fees and 50% of Winter-Term fees. If you withdraw after February 6/2002, you will be assessed full fees for both terms.
