- (1) Students who have not paid their fees in full by this date, or made satisfactory alternate arrangements, will be assessed late payment penalty charges.
- (2) Students withdrawing after this date will be assessed full fees.
- (3) If you withdraw from a two-term course from May 19 to July 9, 2009, you will be assessed full fees for the Spring Term. If your Faculty determines that you may have special permission to withdraw from July 10 to 20, 2009, you will be assessed Spring Term fees and 50% of Summer Term fees. After July 20, 2009, you will be assessed full fees for both terms.
- (4) Beyond this date, registration will be cancelled for nonpayment of the deposit. Registrations commenced from the first day of class in a term until the registration deadline do not require a confirmation deposit.
