
## Classroom Startup & Quick Reference Guide




- **A** Computer

## Operate the Computer

Ensure the **computer** (A) is turned on before use.

- Find the **power symbol button .** NOTE: The location of this button may vary from classroom to classroom.
- If the **green light** is on, the computer is on. If there is no green light, the computer is off.
- Press the **power button O** to turn the computer on.



## Operate the Classroom Settings

The **control panel** (**D**) can change the following classroom settings:

- Turn the **projector** on and off.
- Select the **computer source** (classroom computer, laptop, etc.) to be displayed on the projector.
- Turn the **room lights** on and off (not available in all classrooms). Lighting controls can also be found on classroom walls.




## Operate the Microphone

There is a built-in  $\operatorname{microphone}(\mathbf{E})$  located on the podium.

A wireless microphone is located in either the podium drawer (F) or the rack drawer (G) depending on the room.

- $\bullet$  Connect the microphone to the classroom via the  $control\ panel.$
- Spare batteries are available in the drawer for your convenience. If empty, please contact IST.
