The Copyright Office is a source of information and guidance for the University of Alberta community on issues related to copyright.

- **1.** Be sure to familiarize yourself with the University of Alberta's UAPPOL <u>Use of Copyright Materials Policy</u> and <u>Procedure</u>
- 2. The <u>Copyright Act</u> has a Fair Dealing exception, and the University of Alberta has developed <u>Fair Dealing Guidelines</u> to help you determine what and how much material you can copy and disseminate for educational use.
- **3.** Using eClass or an LMS? Unsure of what materials you can post to your secure course website? See the <u>"Posting to a Learning Management System</u>" section of our website for more information, or submit a Copyright Review Request Form for an in-depth copyright review.
- **4.** Showing a film or YouTube videos in class? Displaying images in presentation slides? See the <u>"Showing Movies"</u> section on our website for information on educational exceptions for in-class instruction.
- 5. Are you using a print course package? All course packages are subject to review by the Copyright Office. Download our <u>Copyright Review Request Form</u> and submit your request 6-8 weeks prior to the start of your course.
