All University of Alberta medical students from Year 1 to Year 4 are listed under the educational registry of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta.

All University of Alberta medical students from Year 1 to Year 4 have liability coverage. Both WCB and liability coverage are provided by the University of Alberta. More information on their coverage can be found at this link:

All University of Alberta medical students from Year 1 to Year 4 have liability coverage as long as:

- 1. The activity is part of their learning
- 2. The MD Program office is aware of the student's engagement within the learning environment, which includes the date(s), time-frame, and location.

All University of Alberta medical students from Year 1 to Year 4 can scrub in, participate in activities in the OR and in clinics as long as the above conditions are met and at the level of comfort of the preceptor.

Visiting Medical Student Liability Coverage

All visiting medical students have comparable liability agreements through their home schools and provincial regulating bodies.

In the very rare case that a visiting medical student does not have liability coverage, the University of Alberta MD Program provides coverage for them at a cost.
